The learned counsel for the petitioner points out that despite this Court's order with regard to the provision of Section 3(3) of the Street Vendors Act, 2014, street vendors are being evicted. We have also directed on the previous occasion that if any street vendors have been evicted from the areas referred to therein, they shall be permitted to return. Despite this, some street vendors have been evicted. The learned counsel for the petitioner has shown us some documents which indicate that the articles of sale of the street vendors have been confiscated and, thus, the street vendors have made applications for return/release of the same even in December, 2014 after the passing of our previous order.

An affidavit shall be filed along with the documents. The directions given by us

on the previous occasion is reiterated. Any non-compliance will be looked at very seriously.
