This street food festival is being organized by the National Association from 29 December to 31 December at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in Delhi. The festival will be inaugurated by Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri. On this occasion, Chef Kunal Kapoor will be seen with street food vendors.

Along with the inaugural session, Chaupal will be organized on various social topics. In the cultural evening, there will be performances by comic satire poet Shambhu Shikhar, folk singer Neha Rathore and other artists. Events will be organized for the entertainment of children.

The National Street Food Festival 2023 is starting with all its grandeur at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in Delhi from Friday.

This festival will be inaugurated by Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri at 4 pm on the last evening of the outgoing year. After the inauguration of the festival, the Union Minister will taste the food and interact with the stalls set up in the festival. On this occasion, famous chef Kunal Kapoor will also taste the street food vendors and encourage them.

This time foreign dishes have also been added to the festival. Around 400 street food vendors from all four corners of India will participate in this festival in some way or the other. These street food vendors have reached Delhi from distinctive traveling for one to two days. From Friday, all these vendors will showcase their culinary skills.

Major Attention:

Locho from Surat and Turkish Pizza from Turkey!

This time Locho, the traditional taste of Surat, will also add its charm to the festival. Jitendra Bhai, a street food vendor from Surat, says that this dish has recently gained more fame. When Prime Minister Modi took Locho's name at an inauguration in Surat. He says. There is no flexibility in what he says and

does. He and his team add the sweetness of their innocence to Locho. Similarly street food in the form of Turkish pizza is coming to the festival.

Sajji from Pakistan and Chapali from Afghanistan

Delhi is going to witness the availability of usually rare dishes in the National Street Festival starting from 29th December at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in Delhi. Actually, hundreds of food dishes from all over the country are taking part in this festival. But some dishes are making this festival more special. This time, dishes from countries close to India are also going to be served in the festival. Dishes from countries like Afghanistan, Pakistan and Nepal will be seen.

Chapli Kabab from Afghanistan, sajji chicken from Pakistan and traditional food from Nepal will accompany the street foods of India.
