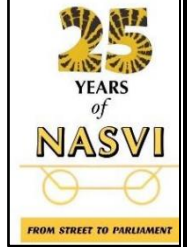




MINUTES OF EC MEETING

Issues Shared by the Members in the Meeting

A number of Issues were shared by the EC Members regarding TVC Meetings, the issuing of COV, and many such.

1. The Municipal Commissioner is not attending the TVC Meetings.
2. The allotted Vending Zones are not given to Street Vendors.
3. NULM Vendors are interfering in the work of Dharmshala Municipal Corporation.
4. Survey has not occurred for years in many states
5. Regular eviction of Street Vendors from their areas of vending due to reasons such as the Construction of Metro (Himachal Pradesh), and MahaKumbh (Allahabad).
6. The demand for renewal of TVC Cards.

Decisions taken in the meeting

1. The members whose ticket has been booked and will not come to the meeting without an appropriate reason, will have to reimburse the amount of the ticket
2. A meeting will be held in Surat, Gujrat between 10-15th December.

3. Another Meeting is decided to be held in Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh between 10-15th December
4. The State Government should be pressurized to issue a letter regarding the implementation of the law and TVC Meetings.
5. A book on the power of TVC should be made
6. A book on the National Street Food Festival should be published so that the vendors can know more about it and participate it in more.
7. Regular TVC Leaders meetings should be held regularly.
8. Protest must be organized at regular intervals by the TVC Leaders.
9. Proposal of forming the Andhra Pradesh State Federation
