



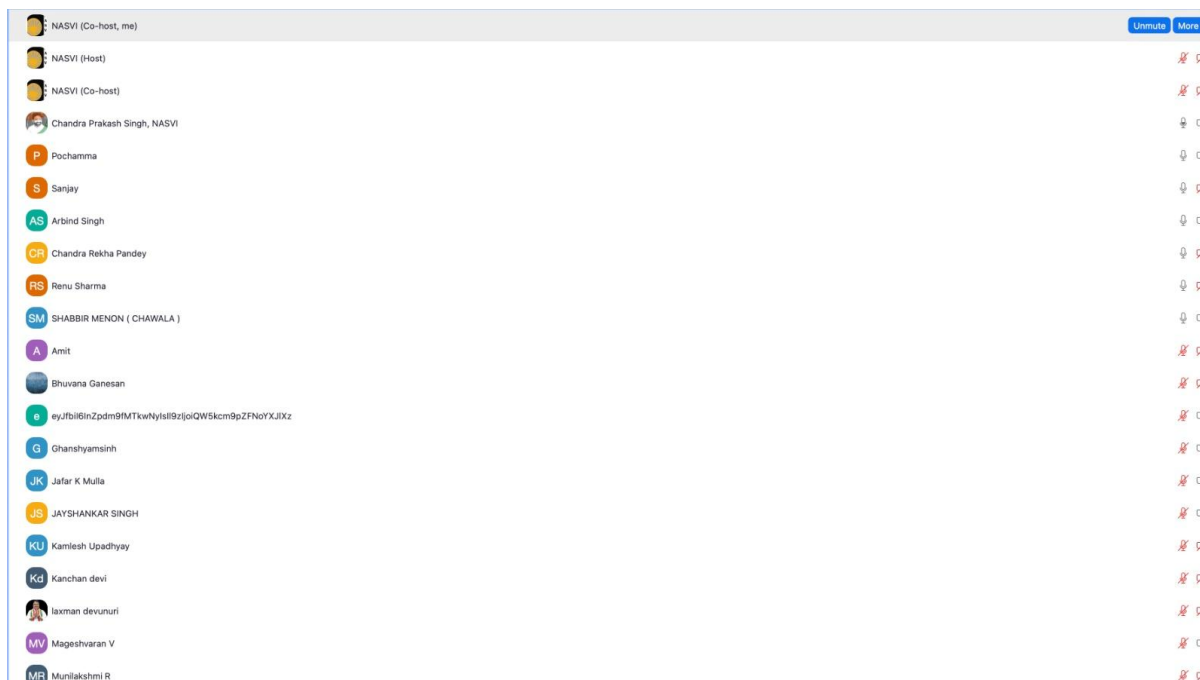
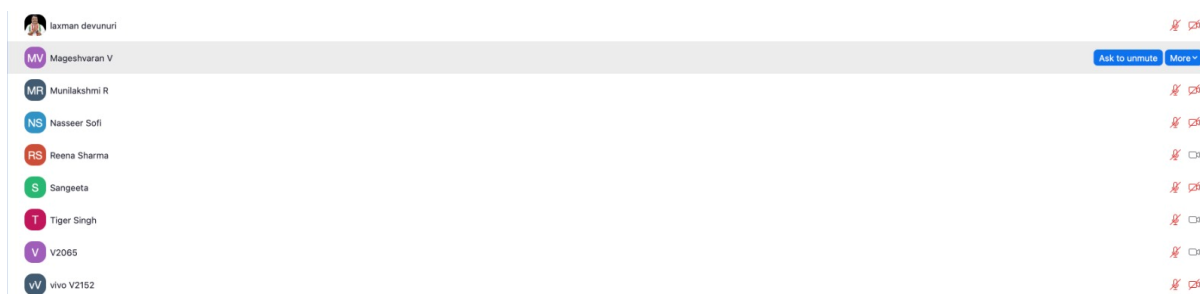
Executive Committee Zoom Meeting

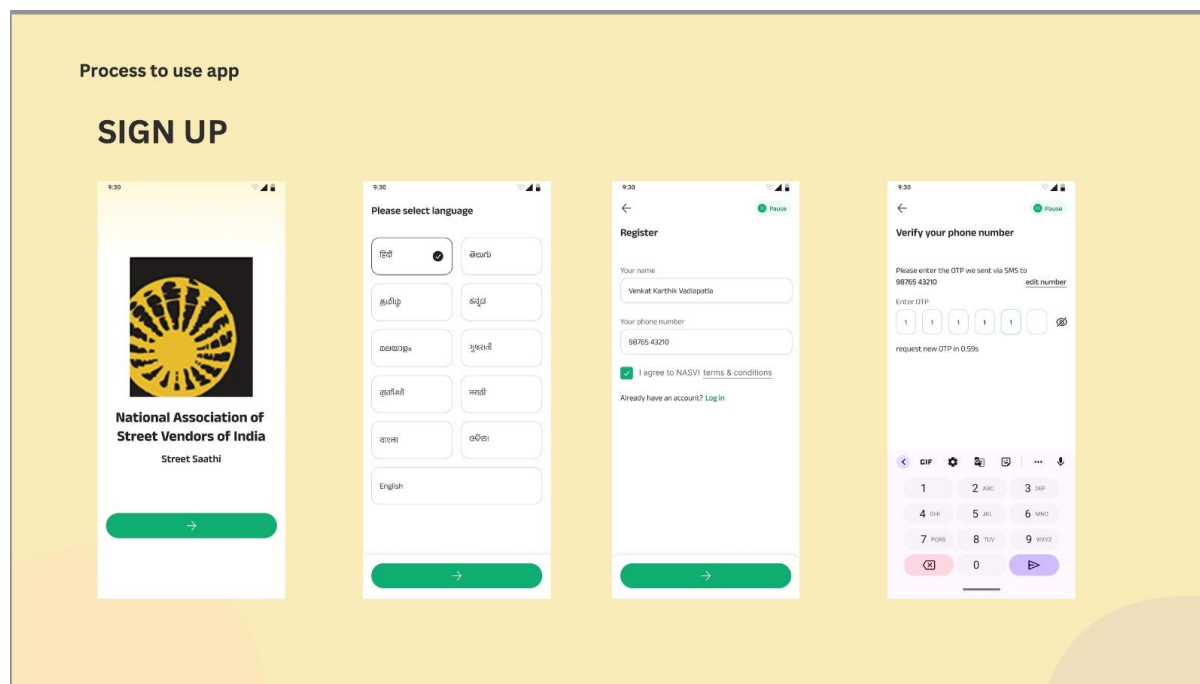
NASVI in Hyderabad

Today, the Secunderabad Commissioner discussed the issues of Mettiguda Street Food Wonders with the NASVI Telangana team and the Commissioner. Later, on the way from Mattiguda to Tarnaka, the State team visited Amber June.






Later, Shri Kanishk Jaiswal presented a report on the Street Sath Application and its promotion. NASVI has been working on the application for a long time and now it is among the vendors to register and enroll.



State reports were presented by the EC members, Many successes and some challenges & issues were also shared in the meeting.

Shri Mageshwaran from Tamil Nadu shared his state report and suggested that NASVI should write letters to officers' training institutes as officers who are appointed in the corporation are unaware of NASVI and the Street Vendors Act 2014.

Shri Rishi Narayan from Varanasi shared his state report and emphasized the importance of organization building and they need to take the initiative and raise their voices.

Smt. Reena Sharma from Assam shared some of the issues street vendors of Assam are facing with evictions and lack of vending zones.

Shri Sanjay Chopra from Uttarakhand shared that the pink vending zone which has been dissolved is not working and we need to move to court regarding this matter.

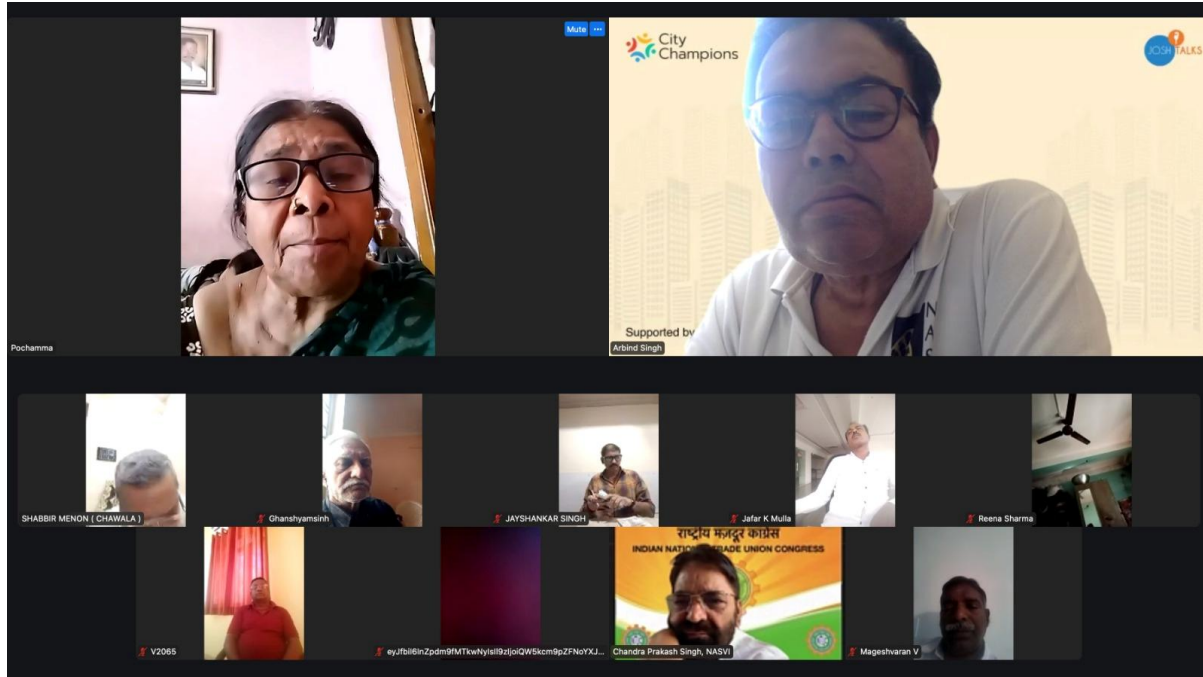
Other members also shared the activities of their states. Some important suggestions and decisions were taken in the meeting.

Suggestions from the EC Meeting.

1. A campaign for the Street Sathi Application should be conducted so it can reach every vendor.
2. VENDINGZONEFORALL, A campaign demanding a vending zone for all will be launched in the month of April.
3. An expert group of academicians, journalists, lawyers, and more stakeholders will be formed.
4. A letter to every Executive Member will be issued by NASVI signifying they are NASVI members.
5. Insurance benefits to vendors will be included in the Street Sathi Application.

Decisions taken in the EC Meeting.

1. The Annual General Meeting will be conducted in the month of July 2025
2. From 1st April all complaints will be taken by Street Sathi Application.
3. The Executive Committee meeting will be held in month of April.

The meeting ended with a lot of learnings and direction, with the president's remark on how important it is to work together. He also mentioned that in times of financial difficulty, the members will work and support together to each other.
