

ORDER

In pursuance of Notification No. 2/2/2017-RII dated 31 January 2017 issued by the Government of Haryana, Urban Local Bodies Department, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 36 of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 (Central Act 7 of 2014), the Haryana Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Rules, 2017 were notified for regulating street vending activities in the State of Haryana. As per Section 2(1)(c) of the said Rules, the “Competent Authority” in the case of a Municipal Corporation is the Commissioner.

Further, Clause 6(4)(vi) of the Haryana Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Scheme, 2020 vests the power to restrict, evict, and relocate street vendors in the Town Vending Committee (TVC) in public interest.

In accordance with the above Rules and Scheme, the Town Vending Committee, in its meeting held on 03.06.2022, constituted a committee comprising the Joint Commissioner-II, MCG; Deputy Municipal Commissioner (DMC), MCG; City Project Officer (CPO), MCG; Assistant Project Officer (APO), MCG; and Shri Rajender Singh Saroha, General Secretary, DRFC, to inspect the two vending zones and examine the feasibility of settlement and rehabilitation of vendors operating therein.

Subsequently, the Deputy Municipal Commissioner, MCG was transferred, and Shri Rajender Singh Saroha declined to participate in the site inspection. The remaining committee members conducted a site inspection of the vending zones located near Vita Dairy and Mother Dairy Booth, Sector 14 on 27.01.2026 and submitted their report.

The committee observed that there are serious issues relating to vehicle parking and smooth flow of traffic in the area. Both vending zones are located on the main internal road of Sector 14, and their existence has resulted in traffic congestion and obstruction, causing inconvenience to the general public.

An alternative site has been identified on the road from Maharana Pratap Chowk to Atul Kataria Chowk, near DAV Public School, Sector 14, for creation of a new vending zone. The committee inspected the proposed site and found it suitable. The Local Councillor (Ward No. 25), District Town Planner (Enforcement), GMDA, and City Project Office, MCG have also inspected the site and concurred with the suitability of the proposed location for accommodating the vendors presently operating near Vita Dairy and Mother Dairy Booths.



In view of the committee's recommendations and considering the obstruction to traffic flow and public inconvenience caused due to encroachment at parking areas near Vita Dairy and Mother Dairy Booths in HSVP Market, Sector 14, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram under the Haryana Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Rules, 2017, I, Pradeep Dahiya, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, hereby approve the recommendations of the committee.

Accordingly, it is ordered that all vendors presently operating in the vending zones near Vita Dairy and Mother Dairy Booths, Sector 14, shall be shifted with immediate effect to the newly identified vending zone located between Maharana Pratap Chowk and Atul Kataria Chowk, near DAV Public School, Sector 14. The areas near Vita Dairy and Mother Dairy Booths, Sector 14 are hereby declared as "No Vending Zones."

The concern Joint Commissioner, MCG is directed to ensure strict compliance with the above orders with immediate effect.
